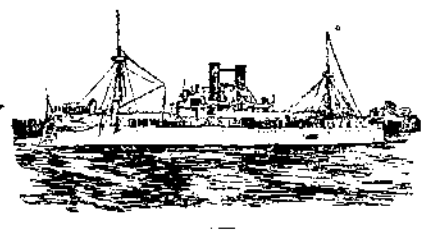

WARSHIP MAINE BLOWN TO PIECES

Powerful United States Naval Vessel Sent by the Government to Cuban Waters Destroyed in the Harbor of Havana

Catastrophe Took Place at 10 O'clock at Night, When All the Sailors Except Those Detailed for Duty Were Sleeping.

One Explanation of the Terrible Disaster Is that a Grenade Was Thrown Into the Cruiser's Magazine by Spaniards' War Spirit Rifle.



AMERICAN BATTLESHIP MAINE was blown to pieces in Havana harbor on the night of Feb. 15, 1898. The explosion, which occurred at 10 o'clock at night, destroyed the vessel and killed 266 of her crew. The cause of the disaster is still a matter of debate, but one theory is that a Spanish war spirit rifle was thrown into the ship's magazine, causing the explosion.

The Maine was sent to Havana harbor on a mission of goodwill. She was the first American battleship to visit the harbor since the Spanish-American war. The ship was commanded by Captain Charles D. Sigsbee. She was accompanied by the USS Albatross, a minesweeper, and the USS Thetis, a torpedo boat.

The explosion occurred in the ship's magazine, which was located in the bow of the ship. The magazine was filled with shells and other explosives. The explosion was so powerful that it blew the ship apart and sent a large plume of smoke and fire into the air.

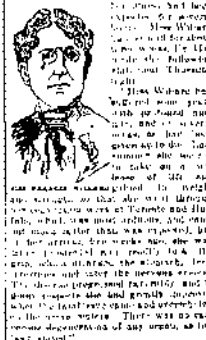

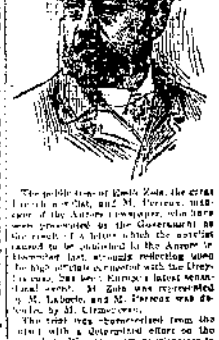
