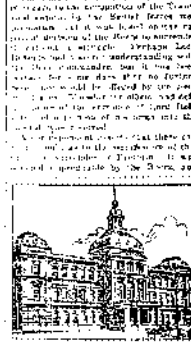


Map of China showing military movements and battle locations.

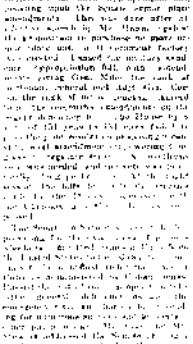


Map of South Africa showing Pretoria and military movements.
