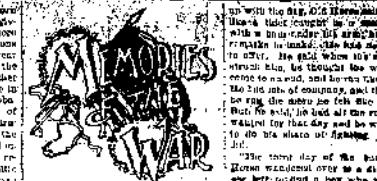

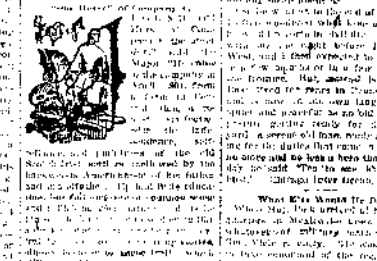

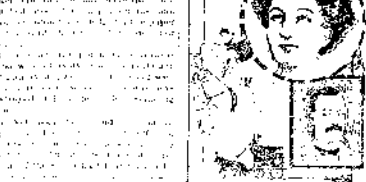


A WESTERN WIND, AT WORK.
