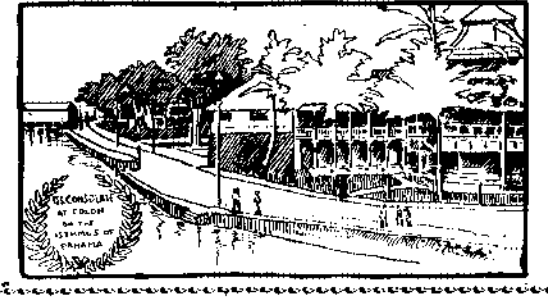
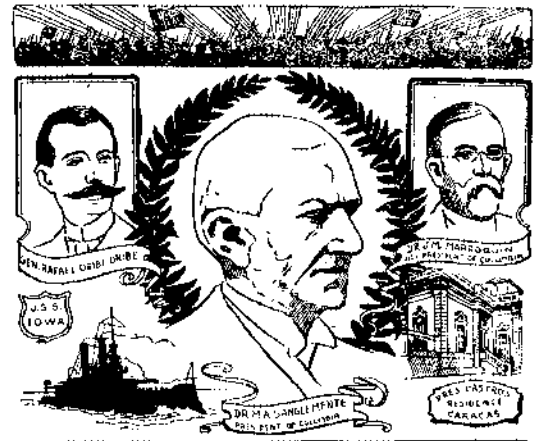

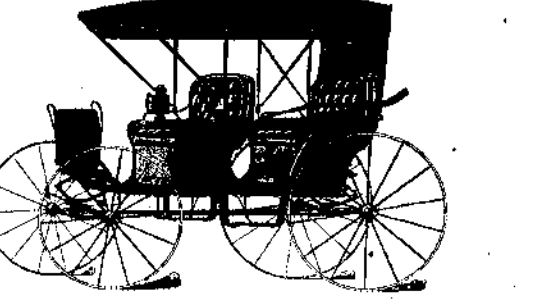

FIRST PAGE FOR SPEECHES.

Secretary Among Congressmen Who A Good Position in the Record.

The first page of the Congressional Record is now reserved for the speeches of the members of the House of Representatives and the Senate. This is a change from the former practice when the first page was given to the President's message. The change is the result of a bill introduced by Mr. McMillan of Michigan, which was passed by the House on August 10. The bill provides that the first page of the Record shall be given to the member whose speech is read on that day. This will give the member whose speech is read the first page of the Record, which is the most prominent position in the publication. 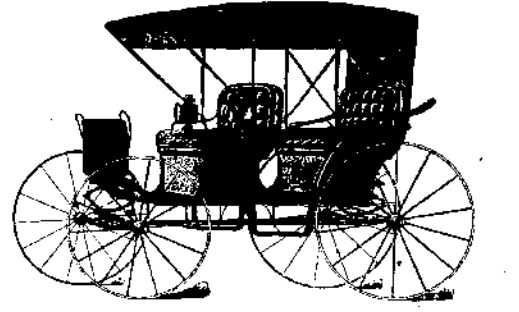
