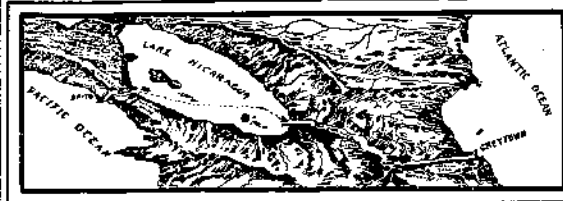

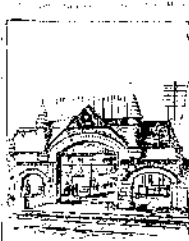


Illustration of a large building, possibly a stock exchange or a government building.

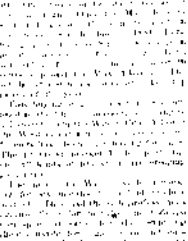


Illustration of a man's face, possibly a politician or a businessman.

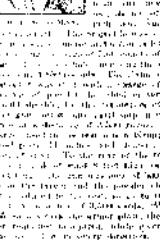

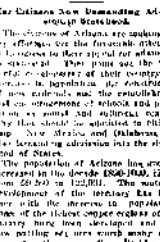

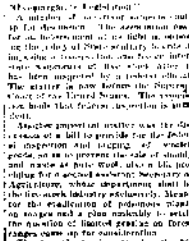


Illustration of a large building, possibly a stock exchange or a government building.

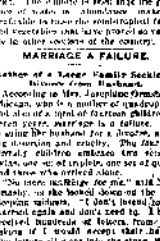

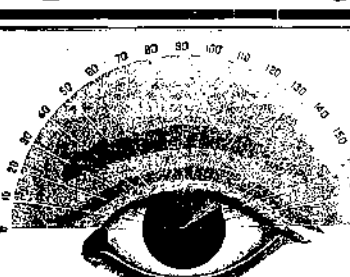

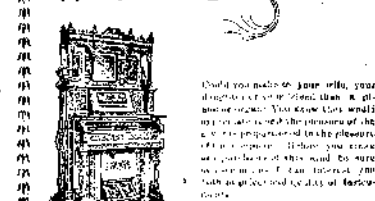
