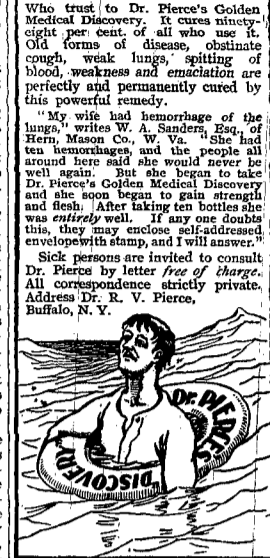

Meeting called to order by Nelson Grimley, chairman Neely being unaccountably absent, and called by secretary C. M. Craven, after which convention proceeded to organize. Nelson Grimley was elected temporary chairman and H. E. Siman temporary secretary.

On motion the delegates present were authorized to cast full vote of their precincts. On motion temporary organization was made permanent.
