WASHINGTON AS BUSINESS MAN.

Probably the Largest Land Owner in the United States.
As a man of business Washington was extremely methodical. Everything was figured down to the penny, and there was no guesswork about the returns from any of his properties. He was eminently successful, and his property consisted of 150,000 acres, not including his wife's estate, amounting to \$300,000. He was probably the largest owner of land in America, his holdings extending 50,000 acres. The Mount Vernon estate came into the possession of the Washington family in 1754. It originally consisted of 5,000 acres, and was later increased by Washington from his brother Lawrence. The property was just half that size. Washington was in the market for all the available land adjoining, and at the time of his death he owned 8,000 acres in the immediate vicinity of his residence. The land was purchased by Washington from his brother Lawrence. The French and Indian war, and by buying out the patents of other officers he secured ownership of more than 40,000 acres of land in the western part of the colony. He made large sales from this domain, but what was left was valued at over \$300,000 in the inventory of his property.
