ORDINANCE NO. 84-5. AN ORDINANCE CREATING STORM SEWER DISTRICT NO. 84-1 IN THE CITY OF WAYNE, NEBRASKA.

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Council of the City of Wayne, Nebraska, having fully investigated and considered the storm water drainage conditions of said City and being fully advised in the premises thereof,

SECTION 2. There is hereby created within said City of Wayne, Nebraska, a storm sewer district known as Storm Sewer District No. 84-1.

SECTION 3. 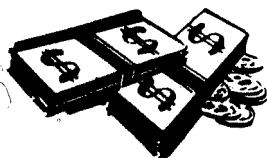
