







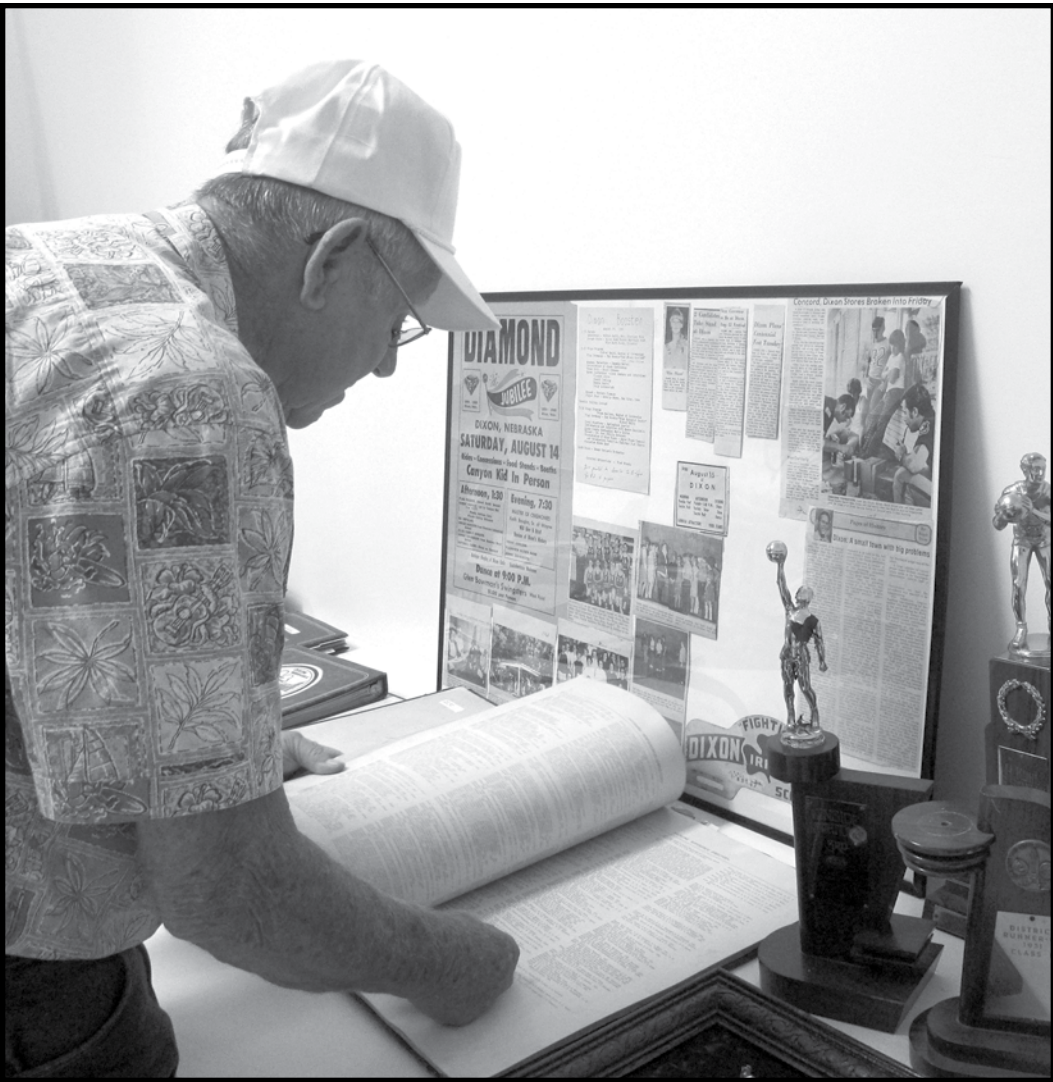








# DIXON CELEBERATES Q 125

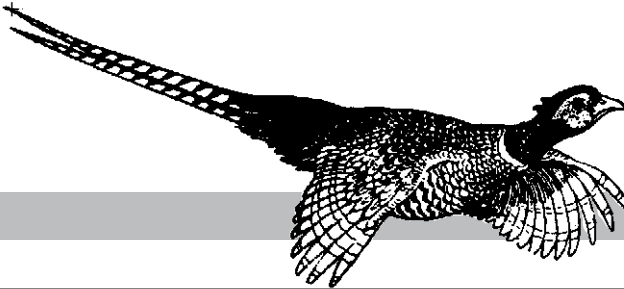

## Capitol View Rural issues look interesting

If it's time for the University of Nebraska-Lincoln football team to start playing home games, it must be time for the Legislature's Interim Study Hearing Schedule to fill up.

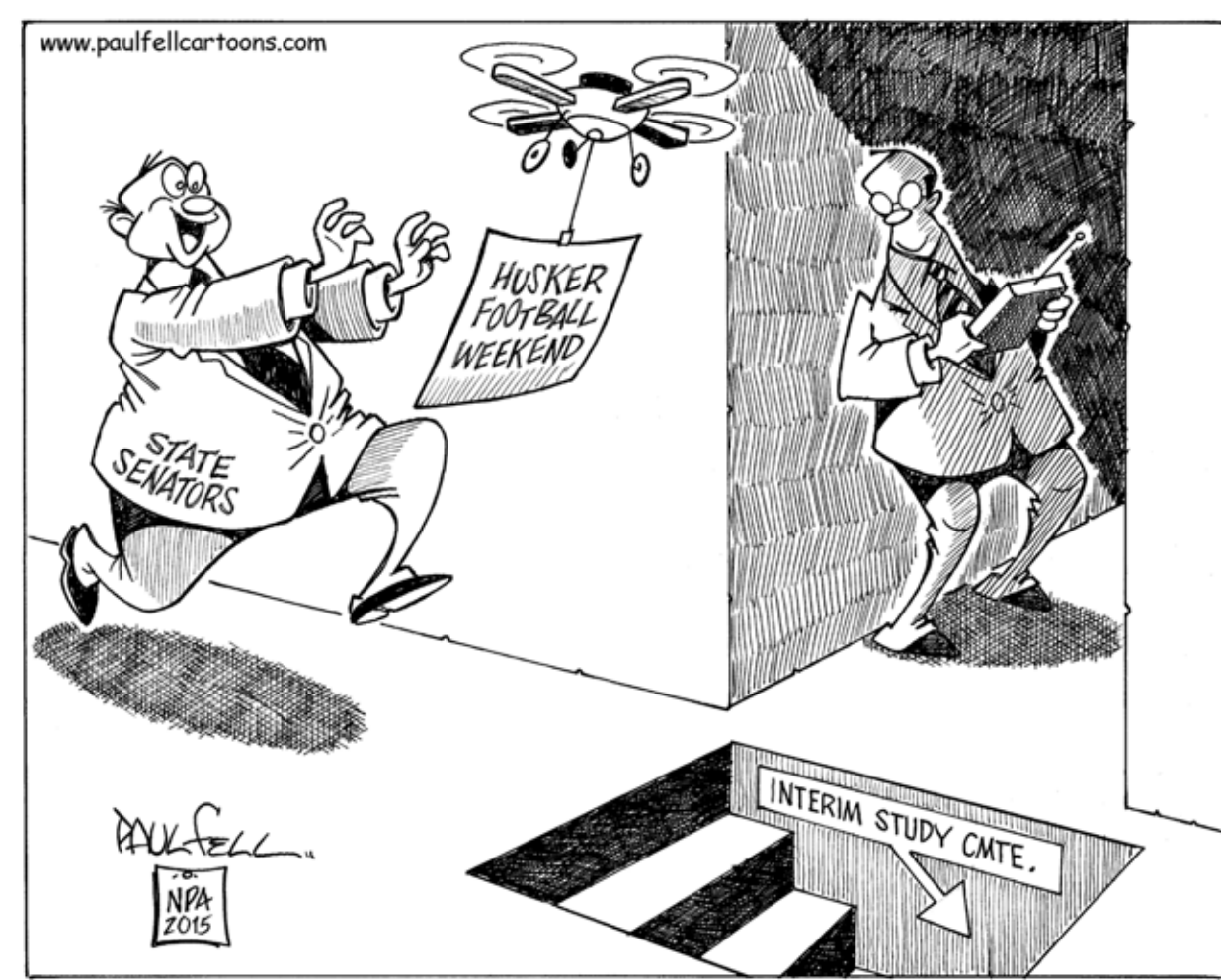
Yes, lawmakers like to travel to Lincoln (they get paid for it) to attend interim hearings at the Capitol on Fridays and then attend home football games on Saturday. It seems it has ever been thus. If that's what it takes to lure them to town when they aren't in session, so be it.

Now, for the studies themselves. There are hundreds scheduled each year and every committee has some to consider before the next session convenes. Lawmakers explain that is how they get the information they need to formulate new bills or tweak existing law.

Many of these are not the headline grabbers that topics such as prison or taxation reform might be, but they are still important to the fabric of life in Nebraska. Several being heard by the Urban Affairs Committee and one by Revenue deal with issues of importance to rural Nebraskans.

The first is a study of the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act, commonly referred to as local tax or LB840 (Laws 1991) funding. Six lawmakers introduced Legislative Resolution 152 to look at the nearly 25-year-old law by reviewing its history, the eligible uses of the funds, the potential new uses for the funds and an examination of the process used to amend an existing LB840 plan and whether or not such a plan requires voter approval.

The Sept. 25 hearing comes one day before the Nebraska vs. Southern Mississippi home game. The current act, which has been modified 13 times since first adopted in 1991, authorizes incorporated cities and villages to collect and appropriate local tax dollars (sales and/or property tax) if approved by the local voters, for economic development purposes. It is being used in 68 communities from Chadron to Falls City and Kimball to South Sioux City and a lot of places in-



between. The Act involves the formulation of a local economic development program plan which forms the foundation for the collection and expenditure of local tax revenues for economic development through: direct loans or grants to qualifying businesses for fixed assets and/or working capital; loan guarantees; grants for public works improvements which are essential for business recruitment or retention; job training; purchase of real estate; salary for city staff or consultants to implement the program; bonding; production of films; grants or loans for the construction or rehabilitation for sale or lease of housing for low to moderate income individuals. An economic development program may also include grants or loans for the construction or rehabilitation for sale or lease of housing for persons of low to moderate income. Also up for consideration that same day is LR155 to examine cur-

rent and potential economic development tools available to Nebraska municipalities. This study includes Tax Increment Financing (TIF) as well as LB840 funds. It will also include a review of potential additional economic development tools, which could be made available, including a review of economic development tools currently available in other states and the legality of offering them in Nebraska based on the uniformity and proportionality provisions of the state Constitution. The committee will meet Oct. 28, the day before the Nebraska vs. Northwestern home football game, to consider Lincoln Sen. Patty Pansing Brooks LR278 which would examine the existing resources and the need for additional tools for municipalities to further encourage revitalization of significant and older historic neighborhoods. The study will consider: the need for financial incentives to encourage business investments in declining neighborhoods; the prospect for addition-

al incentives to encourage home ownership of rehabilitated older buildings; the possibility of a collaboration between state and local governments and public and private entities in this endeavor. No date for a hearing has been set yet, but Omaha Sen. Burke Harr has a resolution, LR308, that would examine issues regarding the growth of Nebraska's agricultural related economy to determine what actions can be taken to spur population growth and business expansion in rural communities statewide. The study will consider the delivery and effectiveness of rural economic development programs in Nebraska as well as policies in other states that partner urban and rural areas and promote job creation in rural communities. These aren't the big issues, by any means. But they are very important issues to all Nebraskans and reflect the work that a citizen legislature needs to be doing.

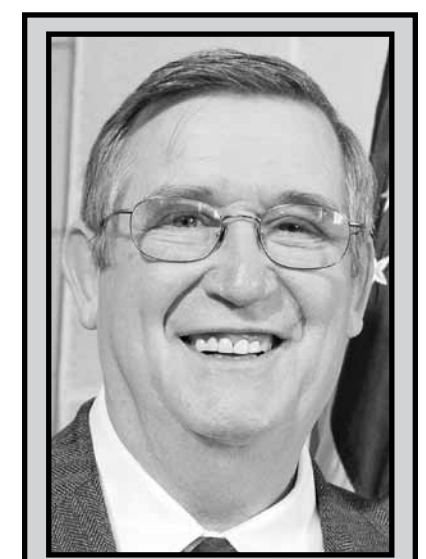
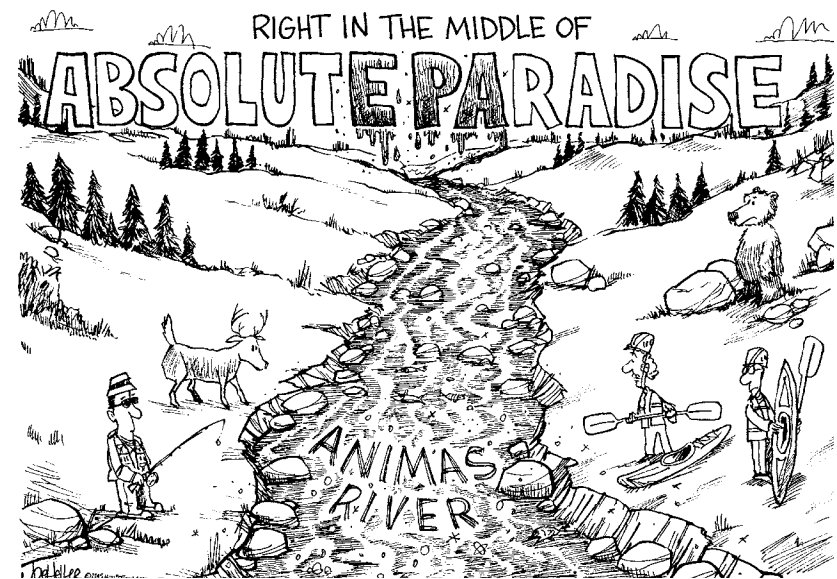

work in the center of the action on the floor of the Legislature and in committee sessions. As a legislative page you will respond to senators' request lights on the legislative floor, run errands, deliver messages, photocopy materials, assist the presiding officer, set up and staff

committee hearings and perform other duties as assigned. Pages must be high school graduates who are currently enrolled in a Nebraska college or trade school with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. They must be able to work 20 hours a week during session and it is preferred that they work the same four-hour shift each day. The legislative ses-

session will begin January 6, 2016, and will go through April of 2016. This is a paid position with first year pages earning \$10.23 per hour and second year pages earning \$10.58 per hour. In addition, a page may also be able to receive credit hours through their college. This is a great opportunity to learn about the legislative process here in Nebraska and make a few dollars to help with school expenses. Jessica, my Legislative Aide, once served as a page, she can explain the process better than I can if you have any questions.

Applications are available from my office in Lincoln: Senator Dave Bloomfield, State Capitol, District 17, P.O. Box 94604, Lincoln, Neb., 68509-4604 or from the Clerk of the Legislature's Office, Room 2018, State Capitol, 1445 K Street, Lincoln, Neb., 68509. If you are interested in becoming a legislative page or have any questions I encourage you to contact my office. I would be happy to submit a letter of recommendation for any eligible student from District 17. This year applications are due by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 30.

## Recognition ceremony held for Northeast PTA students Sunday

Members of the graduating class in Northeast Community College's physical therapist assistant (PTA) program are now ready to enter the profession.

The 16 students from the Class of 2015 took part in a Recognition Ceremony before family, friends and faculty Sunday afternoon in the Lifelong Learning Center.

As part of their studies, the students took part in three clinical affiliations in order to experience working with patients in real life surroundings, according to Laura Schwanebeck, PTA program director.

“The students are assigned clinical instructors, who are practicing clinicians across the country. These clinicians are either physical therapists or they are physical therapist assistants. Their job is to help our students use the skills and knowledge they learned here at Northeast and apply it in a clinical setting when they work with patients. We cannot thank the clinicians enough

for the time they volunteer to work with our students.”

Timothy Brogan, an attorney in Norfolk who spoke to students during the year, served as guest speaker at the ceremony. He told the students that they are entering a profession that offers a problem solving service, much like he provides his clients.

“Nobody is contacting or coming to you on their best of days. But I can tell you that there is nothing more rewarding when somebody who needs help comes to you. I believe you will all excel because your profession is going to change every day of your life as you leave here today. And that is a wonderful, rewarding thing since it won't be the same thing over and over again.”

Brogan challenged each of the students to set goals for themselves and seek opportunities that they will encounter through their employment and their work with people.

“The drive is going to have to come from each one of you internally. Being average is as close to the bottom as it is to the top. You will encounter people who will just want to punch the clock, but I encourage you to find the opportunity to become much greater than that. I challenge you to exceed and excel in your lives as you move on and become the person your patients will

want to be drawn to.”

Dacia Ganseboom, Norfolk, PTA program student president, said the class came together to achieve the goal of becoming PTAs.

“I don't think any of us realized how hard the road would be to get here today. And yet here we are. A lot of blood, sweat and tears were shed throughout this whole process. But somewhere between that first day and today, we became more than classmates. We became a family.”

Other officers this year were Laura Kruger, Norfolk, vice president; Chelsea Haack, Columbus, secretary; Ryan Elsner, Loup City, treasurer; and Shayla Frakes, Hastings, and Michelle Lethcoe, South Sioux City, historians.

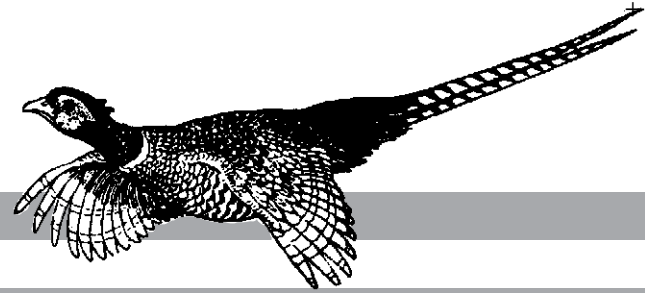

Note: It is important when talking to young children to not use the term love in this content, "I don't love your father/mother anymore." Use the term you are not getting along anymore and it would be better if you lived in separate houses. Leave the word "love" for how you

will always love them (the child/children). Otherwise they see you did love the other parent and now you don't. Does that mean that you might not love me (the child) in the future too?

- Do not discuss each other's faults or problems with the child.

Note: This can be very hurtful to your child. Remember they are a part of both of you. In fact, it may be easy for them to criticize the other parent, but don't join in because it still hurts them to hear criticism about the other parent.

An open communication between you and your child is very important while going through divorce. It is always good to check with your child on how they are feeling.

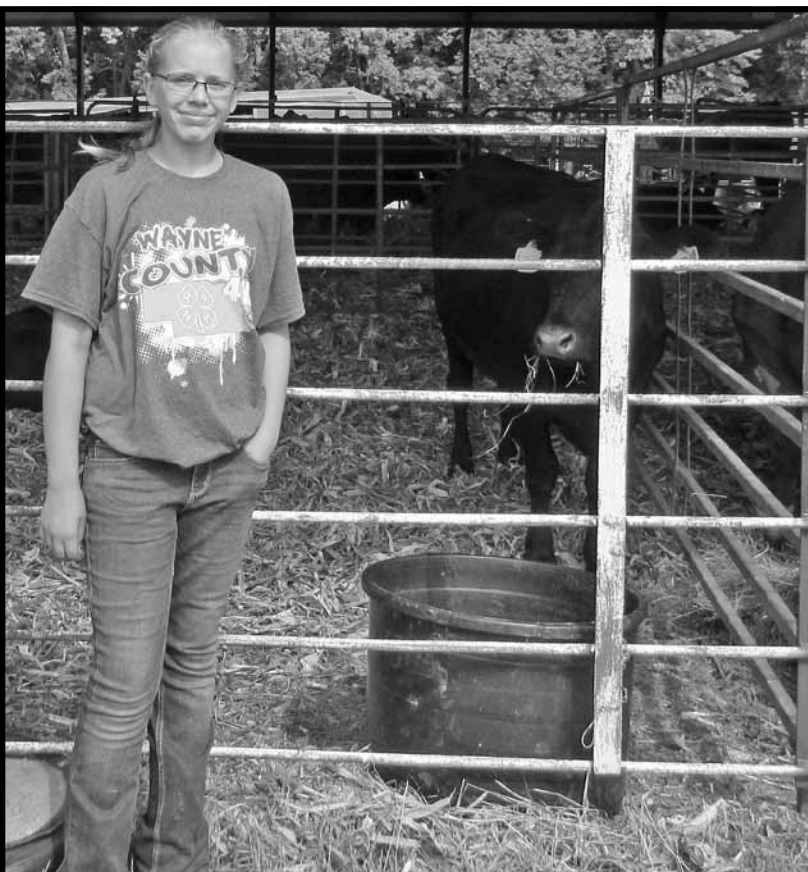

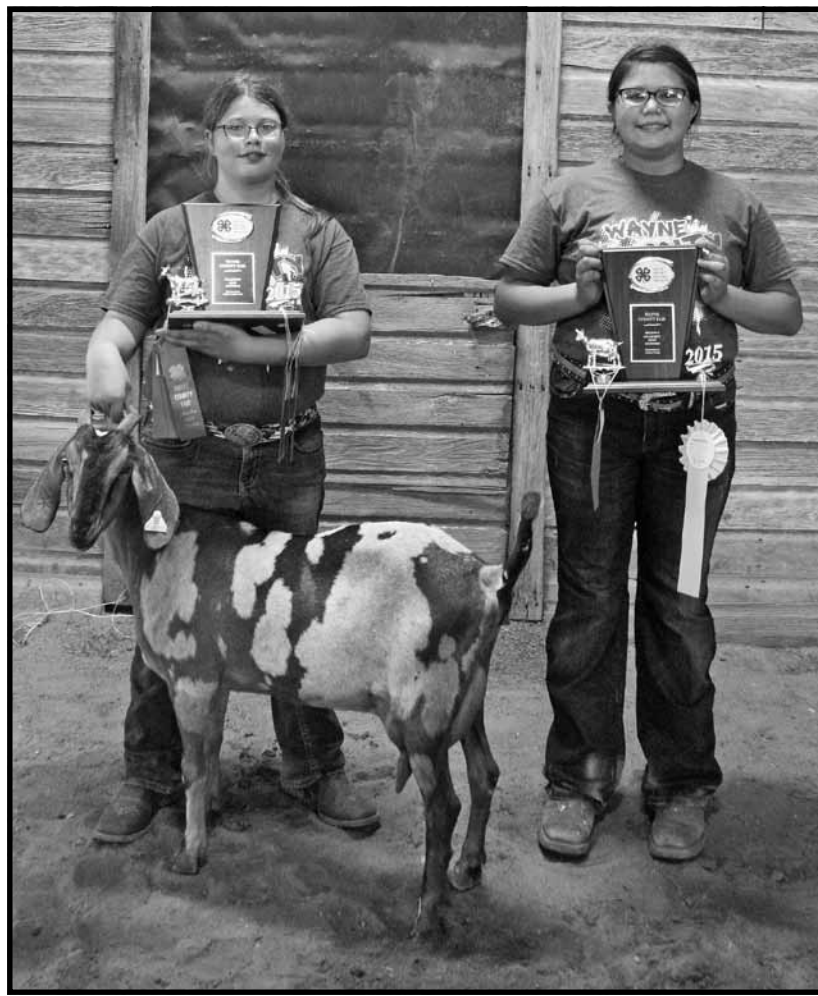
