ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE Nebraska Normal College Association of Wayne, Nebraska.

The undersigned, whose names are subscribed hereto, and their associates and successors, hereby solemnly declare and agree to become a corporation under the statute in such cases provided and shall observe the same as if the same were enacted and shall observe the same as if the same were enacted and shall observe the same as if the same were enacted.

ARTICLE I.

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be at Wayne, Nebraska.

ARTICLE II.

The business and object of this corporation shall be the maintaining and maintaining of a normal school known as the Nebraska Normal College of Wayne, and it may give, authorize or employ any of its stockholders to buy, lease, convey and convey the same to any person or persons and shall have full power to purchase or lease of any land or building or other real estate necessary and incident to the carrying out of the objects of this corporation.

ARTICLE III.

The paid-up capital stock of said corporation shall be Twenty thousand dollars, divided into shares of Twenty-five (\$25.00) each, and shall be paid for in cash or by check.

ARTICLE IV.

This corporation shall commence business on the third (3rd) day of September, A. D. 1901, and continue for a period of seventy years, unless sooner dissolved by consent of a majority of its stockholders.

ARTICLE V.

The annual meeting of the stockholders of this corporation shall be held at Wayne, Nebraska, on the first Tuesday in September of each year.

ARTICLE VI.

The board of trustees shall have power to elect two non-voting members, a president and a vice-president, and to elect such other officers and agents as may be necessary for the management of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII.

The highest amount of indebtedness to which this corporation shall be liable at any one time shall not exceed two-fifths (2/5) of its capital stock.

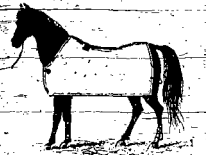

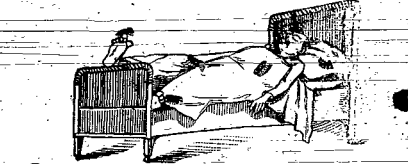
