The assassin narrowly escaped, owing to the heroism of the citizens who rescued him. Officers and even guards immediately secured him and took him to safety, so that he might be killed on the spot. The murderer, a Spaniard, had given the name of Castillo, but it is believed that this was assumed name and the real name is Michael Angel Astur. He declares that he killed General Canovas in the fulfillment of a just revenge, because of the conduct of the Spanish government in its treatment of the anarchist martyrs. He is believed to have arrived at Seville, Andalusia on the same day as the premier, and has been frequently working in the parishes of the latter, particularly in a neighborhood.

## FLORIDA'S ORANGE CROP.

Orange Yield—The Orange crop, 100,000 bushels and 200,000 boxes, offered at the Florida Fruit Exchange in Jacksonville, who keep statistics on the condition of the orange crop throughout the state, can estimate that the crop this fall will amount to between \$50,000 and \$60,000 boxes. The bulk of the

crop will be shipped to New York and Boston, while the remainder will

come north with from \$2,000 to \$20,000 boxes.

The crop probably has reached

its peak, but it is not known for

how long it will last.

In the spring and early summer, this

classed quality of small oranges drop

from the trees, especially in the middle

orange groves, and in the fall, in

the late autumn, there is a

large number of oranges which

are not yet ripe, but are too

shipped to New York and Boston,
