



Havana, Dec. 1.—(UPI)—Insurgents have reported to us that in their meeting with Alexander Miller, minister of Alexander Rodriguez, several letters exchanged between their and Rodriguez left off their names. Rodriguez's letter, however, was signed "A. Rodriguez." It is not known how Rodriguez arrived, but this fact is said to have caused some alarm.

The first letter, written after October 1st, says that everything on the ball is an ongoing, the arrangements being signed to meet the terms of the agreement.

The body of Louis Clark, the original of George Elton's "The Negro Doctor," was buried Saturday afternoon at the cemetery in Lexington.

Thousands of persons were said to be gathered at the Japanese consulate in New York City to protest the Japanese aggression.

Levi George Clark was born in Madison County, Kentucky, the property of Samuel Campbell, a rich All-weather man who was once a member of the Kentucky legislature.

The author of "The Negro Doctor," Campbell, a Madison County, Kentucky, gave away all of his wealth. He died

in Louisville, a September.

**COLLUSION IN ILLINOIS.**

Open Battle Gained a Hard Warlike Seven Days' Truce.

An open battle was fought at Alton, Illinois, Saturday, and the two sides agreed to a truce for seven days. The battle was fought between the forces of General Ulysses S. Grant and General John C. Pemberton, who had been sent to Alton to take command of the garrison. The garrison had been besieged for three weeks, and the rebels had been forced to retreat from the fort.
