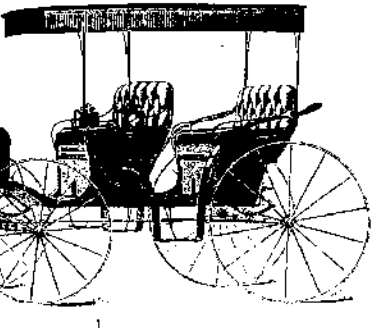

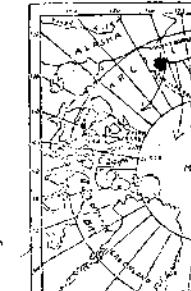

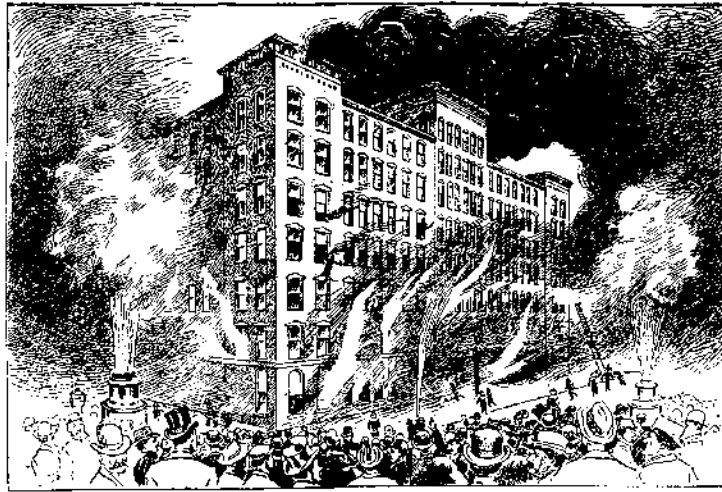
Map of the Arctic region showing ocean currents and the path of the expedition.

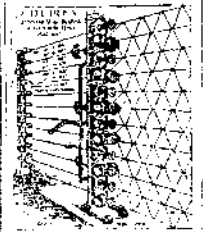
