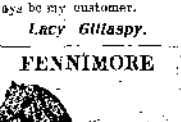



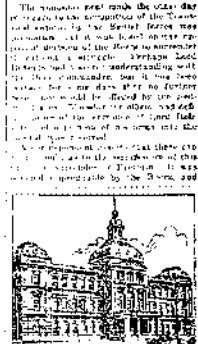


Map of China showing military movements and battle locations.

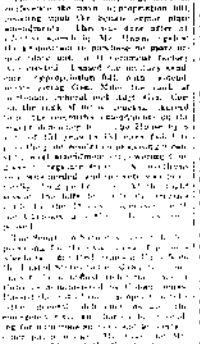


Map of South Africa showing military movements and battle locations.

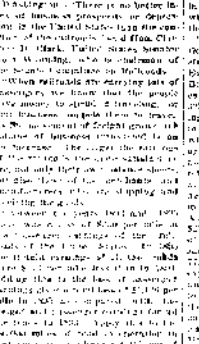


Portrait of Senator C. D. Clark.

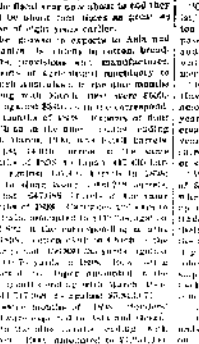


Map of the Pacific Ocean showing trade routes.
