REPUBLICAN COMMITTEEMEN

Under the law for the appointment of judges and clerks of election by the county judges it is a part of the duty of the county judges to nominate persons to act as judges and clerks in their precincts and to have such nominations certified to by the officers presiding over their precincts and the names of such nominees forwarded to the county judge at least ten days before election. The nominees for these places must be able to read, write and speak the English language, be of good character and have resided in the election precinct in which they are to serve at least one month preceding the election in which they are to serve. Under this law the nominees are entitled to take judge and one clerk in the following precincts: Hawkins, Sherman, Deer Creek, Wayne, Plum Creek, Wayne, 1st and 2nd and one judge and one clerk in the following precincts: Garland, Central, Winfield, Hancock, Dennis, Strahan, Hunter, Logan and Lincoln.

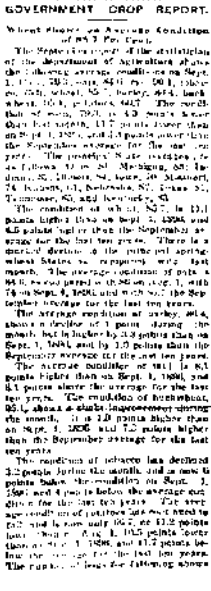
