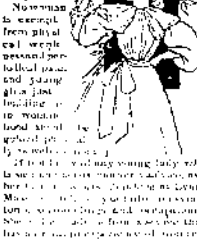

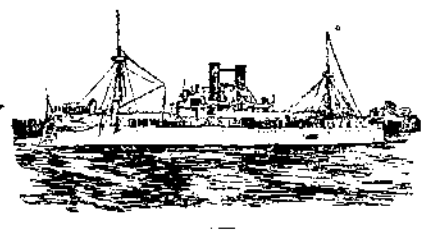

WARSHIP MAINE BLOWN TO PIECES

Powerful United States Naval Vessel Sent by the Government to Cuban Waters Destroyed in the Harbor of Havana

Catastrophe Took Place at 10 O'clock at Night, When All the Sailors Except Those Detailed for Duty Were Sleeping.

One Explanation of the Terrible Disaster Is that a Grenade Was Thrown Into the Cruiser's Magazine by Spaniards' War Spirit Rifle.



At 10 o'clock on the night of Feb. 15, 1898, the United States battleship *Maine* was blown to pieces in Havana harbor. The ship, which had been sent to Cuba in 1895, was destroyed by a mysterious explosion that killed 266 men and wounded 139 others. The disaster was the result of a Spanish war spirit rifle being thrown into the ship's magazine, which caused a fire that spread to the powder magazines and blew the ship apart.

The *Maine* was a powerful battleship, the first of her class, and was one of the most advanced warships in the world at the time. She was sent to Havana harbor in 1895 to show the flag and to protect American interests in the region. The ship was commanded by Rear Admiral C. R. Meade and had a crew of 350 men.
