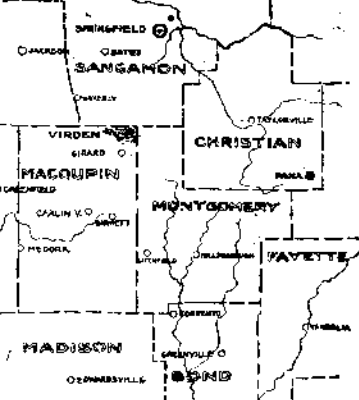

# MAP SHOWING SEAT OF MINING OUTBREAKS IN KENTUCKY.



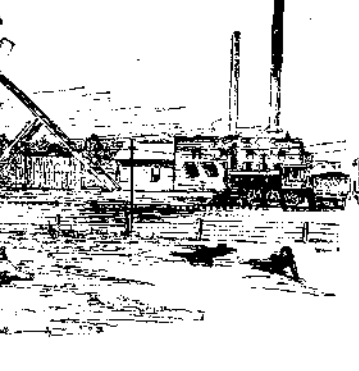
