## HOW TO PLANT CORN.

\*\*\*\*\*

About the first of April commence to pick up all the  
loose stones and pile them in piles, then haul them to some  
place where the rain has washed out a ditch and throw them  
in. Now get a cast iron plow with a new point and plow  
the ground well, then harrow with an A shaped harrow  
about six feet wide. Harrow the ground twice. Now get a  
single shovel plow and make furrows about four feet apart,  
not straight furrows, for they may cause crop growth in  
crooked furrows than if straight ones. Furrows cut cross  
ways. Now you are ready to plant if the sign is right. At  
ways plant corn is the right sign. Shell your corn by hand  
and have a good, good looking, barbed wire girl try upon  
with corn and drop four grains in every cross furrow. Have  
a little boy with a tin bucket full of handful of bone dust on  
every boy for fertilizing. Now have an honest, barbed wire  
boy curer the corn with a hoe. That is the way we always  
planted corn.
